- 3. Consideration and possible action: Appointment of Acting City Manager

Mayor Tabor asked Council for direction in search of an Interim/Acting City Manager. Council discussed the short-term appointment of Police Chief Philip Meadows for daily oversight but he has provided his notice of retirement effective February, 2022. Council discussed the possibility of bringing in former City Manager Joe Dickson on a part-time basis. Motion by Councilmember Pittman, seconded by Councilmember Noto to appoint Philip Meadows, the Chief of Police, as acting City Manager as needed. The motion passed the roll call vote unanimously. Council asked Mayor Tabor to contact SGR, the recruiting firm who assisted us a couple of years ago, to get a cost of helping us again and the consensus of Council was to also contact the runner-up candidate from the last search to see if he may still be interested. Mayor Tabor said he would bring a draft job posting to the Council at the next meeting for approval to post locally and through the Texas Municipal League.

Motion by Councilmember Pittman, seconded by Councilmember Noto to adjourn. The motion passed and the meeting adjourned at 7:03 p.m.
