a. Presentation by John White regarding Tres Rios TIRZ/MUD/PUD development in the ETJ

Mr. John White said the Fountain Lakes (formerly Tres Rios) development represents a proposed master-planned community on 1056 acres, north and west of the current city limits, to be developed in phases and includes about 2600 homes. They presented the land plan, inclusive of a thoroughfare plan; drainage and detention plans; PID, PUD, MUD, and TIRZ concepts; annexation agreement; marketing plan; and homebuilding, product, and branding plans.
