## Joe A. Tambrella Park Rules

13302 6th Street

These rules are established by the City of Santa Fe. If you observe anyone breaking these rules, please report it to the **Santa Fe Police Department** by calling (409) **925-2000**.

- 1. Park hours are between dawn to two hours after dark.
- 2. Restrooms facilities are open each day. No person shall loiter or sleep in or about such facilities or use the facilities for purposes other than those intended.
- 3. No reservation system in place for picnic areas or open-air pavilions. First come first serve system.
- 4. Skateboards and skates prohibited.
- 5. All pets must be kept on a leash. Pet owners are responsible for the removal of any waste deposited by their pet.
- 6. All garbage must be disposed of using the receptacles provided. The patron must remove excessive garbage that cannot be properly disposed of in the provided receptacles from the park.
- 7. Glass bottles and containers are prohibited.
- 8. No off-road vehicles are allowed in city parks.
- 9. No open fires allowed except in barbecue grills.
- 10. Gambling is prohibited.
- 11. Firearms, air rifles or any other form of weapon potentially dangerous to human safety are prohibited.
- 12. Golfing is prohibited.
- 13. To remove, damage, mark, deface, disfigure, injure, or tamper with any public buildings, tables, grills, benches, signs or other park property is strictly prohibited and may result in a fine or arrest.
- 14. Loud amplified music or noise is prohibited. Music may not exceed sound ordinance regulations.
- 15. Any person or organization that damages the park before, during or after their event may be subject to repair charges from the City.
- 16. Climbing of trees is not permitted.
- 17. No profanity allowed in Parks.
- 18. Vehicle parking in designated parking areas only.
- 19. There shall be no soliciting on park grounds.
- 20. The sale of merchandise and food on park grounds is prohibited except in conjunction with community events and only with prior city approval.
- 21. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited except in conjunction with community events and only with prior city approval.
