IV. Executive Staff Reports

A. Approval of the Minutes of the EDC Special Meeting on June 13, 2023

Director Wylie made a motion to approve the Minutes of the Economic Development Corporation (EDC) Special Meeting on June 13, 2023. Director Carner seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

B. FM 1764 Project Status Report

Director Wylie informed Economic Development Corporation Director Rudy Zepeda that Bill Manning of Sander Engineering had sent him an email that Director Wylie then asked him to forward to Mr. Zepeda stating that Mr. Manning has attempted to contact Mr. Robert Amato via text and email with no response regarding Mr. Amato's request for tree removal along the fence line. Mr. Zepeda confirmed that he received Mr. Manning's email, which he then read aloud to the EDC Board.

C. Sales Tax Report June 2023 for April 2023 Sales

Mr. Zepeda gave an overview of the April 2023 Sales Tax Report, noting that the EDC is 9.3% above last fiscal year, which is \$81,000.00 more in revenue than originally estimated.

D. Current Budget Update

Mr. Zepeda gave an update of the current budget through May 31, 2023.

Director Wylie brought to the attention of the EDC Board that the agenda item is shortened to read 'Behringer Field' as opposed to the complete name of 'Behringer-Tully Field'. Director Wylie wanted to ensure that the proper designation is made when the motion is made.

Director Wylie then made a motion to approve funding to the City of Santa Fe Behringer-Tully Park Project as described in Local Government Code 505.159 and remit to the City Council for two readings of a resolution authorizing the expenditure. Director Carner seconded the motion. Director Loftin, Director Vicknair, Director Helpenstill, and President Leija voted in favor, while Vice-President Crable abstained due to his position on the Santa Fe Independent School District Board of Trustees, as the City of Santa Fe is purchasing the property from Santa Fe Independent School District. The motion passed.
