Call to Order

Director's Report

- 3. City Council passed the library budget which includes the hiring of a part-time employee. However, the job position is on hold until a decision is made on the expansion since plans are to make this part-time position into a full-time position once expansion is complete.

Unfinished Business

- 1. The city manager suggests that we skip the open house with Council and move straight to a workshop. This will allow more time for council to ask questions. We will still provide the brochure before the workshop. Brenda had a few more changes.
- 2. The Heritage Festival is being organized by the Chamber of Commerce and will be held on Nov 14 at Runge Park. The Friends will be selling books, water, and soft drinks.

New Business

- 1. Brenda discussed a procedure change to the Circulation Policy. Currently, the policy states that a driver's license is required to receive a library card. It does not specify a Texas driver's license. The procedure change is that a card can be issued to a patron with a valid driver's license from any state along with the other proof of residency documentation.
- 2. Santa will be at the library on Dec 12 after the city parade. The library will be closed that Saturday morning but will open at 5:30 for the evening festivities. The Parks department is hosting several events in the park next to the library. The Friends are dressing up in red aprons and jingle bells. Brenda is working on a brief survey for patrons as they wait to see Santa.
