Kim will prepare the packets with scripts and instructions for those buying tickets who wish to be a character in the mystery. Others buying tickets who do not wish to be a character will get a "notes" page to help them solve the mystery. Tickets will be \$20.00 a person. Runge Park will be the site of the event. It rents for \$85.00 for 4 hours with a \$250 deposit.

Sharon will check with Zio's and Hometown Bar-b-que regarding catering for 30 people. We will purchase the desserts from Sam's. We hope to keep food costs at about \$13.00 a person. We should make about a \$400.00 profit, plus have fun.
