Old Business:

1. Discussion: Successes and lessons learned during the Candy Trail on October 28, 2023

- CJ's Stables has been contacted
- Water will be provided in lieu of hot chocolate, which had been previously discussed
- Need to reimburse the Santa Fe High School Culinary Arts Department for the supplies for the cookies
- Park and Recreation Board members should plan to arrive for the event by 4:30 p.m.
- The Boy Scouts will need to be invited to lead the Pledge of Allegiance
- A pastor from a local church will need to be invited to lead the prayer
