I am pleased to inform you that the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) has approved a Community Development Fund (CD) award for Santa Fe in the amount of \$350,000 in support of water improvements. This project will be funded through the Texas Community Development Block Grant (TxCDBG) Program as Contract No. 7219399.

The contract is being drafted and should be emailed to you via DocuSign for electronic signing. The contract must be signed and returned within 30 days of receipt. In addition, TDA acknowledges receipt of your pre-agreement request for administrative and engineering services in your application and approves the request. Costs incurred on or after March 13, 2019 may be considered eligible if all other federal, state, and program requirements have been met.

In an effort to ensure funds are spent in a timely manner, TDA requires any issues related to the approved project to be addressed within 90 days after the date of this award letter - (4 T.A.C. 30.31(b)). Any issues TDA brings to your attention must be addressed within this 90-day period so that the contract can be written and funding for the project can be secured.
