Public Hearing, consideration, and possible action regarding BOA 21-09 Clear Channel Outdoor PGM Holding billboard location described as ABST 47 L CRAWFORD SUR PT OF OUTLOT 324 (324-3) ALTA LOMA OUTLOTS & ADJ ROW being .23 acres located at 12985 Hwy 6, Santa Fe, Texas 77510. Variances Requested: Santa Fe, Zoning Code Section 7.07.03 Billboards Section A:2 and B:1 Digital face not to exceed 580 sq ft; requesting 672 sq ft, Section B:2 Maximum of 500 ft from a platted residential area, requesting 300 ft.

Stacey gives background on the Billboard advises the City would be able to use the billboard for advertisement and emergency purposes. Lee with Clear Channel advises the sign changes with the light outside so it's not blinding. The board messages will change every 8 seconds in a rotation.

Public Hearing opened at 7:18p.m.

Linda Angeloro owner of the shopping center at 12995 Hwy 6 was concerned about the light on the billboard being to bright. Lee advised her that the sign would be higher than it is now and showed her what it would look like. The Pignataro family reached out to Stacey, and they had no objection to the billboard and felt that it would improve Santa Fe and help the businesses advertise in the City. Stacey Baker advised this one billboard will take the place of the two existing billboards. She also advised that there would be no more debris falling off the billboard into the road.
