# **MINUTES**

I. The meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m. by Commissioner Dawn Sharp

III. The Invocation was given by Commissioner Wayne Bacot and the pledge to the U.S. Flag and to the Texas Flag was led by Commissioner Dawn Sharp.

# IV. CITIZENS' COMMENTS

There were no citizen comments.

#### V. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

a. Commissioner Unger made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 5, 2022, Regular Meeting as presented. Commissioner Bacot seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

#### VI. VARIANCES

- a. **Public Hearing BOA 221101** a variance request regarding sections 4.02.04.E Rear Yard and 4.02.04.F Side Yard, of ARTICLE 4. ZONING DISTRICTS of the City of Santa Fe, Texas Zoning Ordinances.
  - i. Request: to allow a structure constructed within the 15-foot rear yard building and 6-foot side yard setbacks to remain in its current location.
  - ii. Location: 15730 North Tower Circle, Santa Fe, Texas; Lot 31 Block 1, Tower Road Estates Phase II.

City Engineer Matthew Johnson explained that this agenda item had been postponed until the applicant could get a letter of encroachment from CenterPoint Energy for the structure to remain in the easement. Mr. Johnson explained the applicant had a storage shed in the CenterPoint Energy easement, built by a contractor who did not obtain permits from the city.

Commissioner Dawn Sharp opened the public hearing at 7:33 p.m.

The applicant, Tamra Loftin, who resides at 15730 North Tower Circle, Santa Fe, Texas, explained that once she was notified that no permits had been pulled, she came

to City Hall and applied for the building permits. CenterPoint Energy stated that she could apply for the \$800 application for encroachment, but that the application did not guarantee that the company would accept the encroachment. She brought a notarized letter stating she takes full responsibility for the building in the event it needs to be moved at her expense. Ms. Loftin stated she did not contact the contractor after she learned the building did not have permits pulled and was in the easement.

Commissioner Dawn Sharp closed the public hearing at 7:38 p.m.

- b. **Consideration and possible action regarding BOA 221101** a variance request regarding sections 4.02.04.E Rear Yard and 4.02.04.F Side Yard, of ARTICLE 4. ZONING DISTRICTS of the City of Santa Fe, Texas Zoning Ordinances.
  - i. Request: to allow a structure constructed within the 15-foot rear yard building and 6-foot side yard setbacks to remain in its current location.
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Following a brief discussion about the request, Commissioner Bacot made a motion to deny the request for a variance and the require Ms. Loftin to move the building into compliance within eight months. Commissioner Sharp seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
