a. Consideration and possible action: Adoption of a resolution designating an engineering service provider to complete application and project-related engineering services for the Texas Department of Emergency Management Hurricane Harvey DR-4332 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)

City Manager Joe Dickson said staff solicited Requests for Qualifications for engineering services for this HMGP

project with the Drainage District for drainage system improvements. LJA Engineering was the only response received, and they have been determined as a qualified and responsive provider. Motion by Councilmember Corey Jannett, seconded by Councilmember O'Brien to adopt the resolution designating LJA Engineering as the engineering service provider to complete application and project-related engineering services for the Texas Department of Emergency Management Hurricane Harvey DR-4332 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP). b. Consideration and possible action: Approval of landscape architecture design for Mae S. Bruce park City Manager Joe Dickson said a park re-development master plan has been prepared for the Mae S. Bruce park to provide for a healing garden and park for the community to remember, heal, and celebrate life. The proposed design provides for the removal of large shrubs around the gazebo, removal of certain trees and tree stumps, removal of the concrete pad and chainlink fence, and removal of the existing playground equipment, which will be relocated to the Joe A. Tambrella park. The new design includes the installation of a wood fence, resetting the sidewalk bricks, refinishing the gazebo and ramp, planting new trees, and adding a contemplative garden and seating area. Motion by Councilmember O'Brien, seconded by Councilmember Corey Jannett to approve the landscape architecture design for the Mae S. Bruce park. The motion passed the roll call vote unanimously.
